The chairperson opened the AGM, thanking everyone for attending, the coaches for their time and dedication over the season and the parents for transporting the children to and from training sessions and games.

- 1) **Registration:** Almost 400 registered with nearly 50 dribblers. Vojkan will continue to assist with a skills development programme from dribblers upwards. A coach as well as parents to collect monies will be required for the coming season.
- 2) **U10 League:** Co Board will review an U10 league or alternatively a blitz once a month. It is against FIBA rules to run an U10 league but the board will look at it. The requirement is to have more games at all levels. U10 boys could enter the U11 league
- 3) **Review of all teams:** U11s Boys reached Cup Final. U11 Boys B team struggled as all players in on league. U12 and U14 Boys achieved the double; U14 joint league and cup winners. . U12 and U14, U16 and U18 Girls at Div. 1 were competitive. One of the aims of the club is to get

more teams playing in Div. 1. U16/U18 Boys were not allowed to regrade but playing at Div 1 provided good training.

- 4) **Players selected for Kerry team:** Well done to all of those players selected to play for Kerry. The club would encourage all players to attend trials.
- 5) **Tournaments:** There was an U16 tournament. The club would encourage all teams to attend as many tournaments as they can during the season. Sites like the Co. Cork Board website advertise tournaments that are taking place.
- 6) **Garda Vetting:** Most coaches are now garda vetted. Any new coaches coming through will have to be vetted.
- 7) **Coaching:** Need to boost coaching expertise and assistance for coaches. Shane and Vojkan will put in a plan outlining the club ethos and way of playing. This system to be identified, planned and implemented. Co Board are running a level 1 course. Shane and Vokjan will host a skills sessions in August. Again recruiting parental support is an aim. Parents to take on: collecting monies, help with fixtures i.e. help with driving and sending out texts. A coaches meeting will be scheduled for August.
- 8) **Financials:** Financial report for 2018/19 presented.
- 9) **Fundraising:** One of the main ideas discussed was to host a 'monster bingo'.
- 10) **First Aid Bags:** A supply of first aid bags including ice packs to be supplied to all coaches.
